Purpose:

Fills gap in Substance Abuse Continuum of Care

- ***Prevention***
- Early Intervention
- Treatment
- Recovery

Early Intervention Program

IOM Prevention Categories

- Universal – Y'all come
- Selected – certain groups
- **Indicated : Early Stages of SA**

Kentucky Model

Kentucky Early Intervention Program –
Only statewide EIP System in U.S.

Early Intervention Program

Formed Workgroup of WV Partnership

Intervention Workgroup

Met about every 2 months for two years

Developed model

Selected tentative demo sites

No funding available

Early Intervention Workgroup

Model generally followed KY Model

- Referrals
- Parental Involvement
- Assessment/Screening
- Impact Orientation Session
- Education Program
- Follow up
